## Instructions to Authors

All manuscripts of research articles, review papers and short communications will be subject to peer review. Manuscripts submitted for publication in the *Journal of Bamboo and Rattan* should not have been published or submitted for publication elsewhere. Manuscripts found unsuitable in terms of the requirements of the journal will not be processed further. Authors from non-English speaking countries are encouraged to have the manuscripts checked for language before submission. Illustration and other materials, reproduced from other publications, must be properly credited for. Copyright of the article will be vested with the publisher. Submission of manuscripts by e-mail is encouraged. Please send them as attachment to [jbr@kfri.org](mailto:jbr@kfri.org) as separate files: text, line drawings, figures, figure legends, tables, references, *etc.* Alternatively, send the soft copy in a floppy disc or CD by mail/airmail.

## Form of manuscripts

Manuscripts should be prepared in double space. Footnotes and cross references should be kept to the minimum. Do not justify the right-hand margin. Names of genera and species should be italicized. The pages should be numbered consecutively starting with the title page and through the text, reference list, tables, figures and figure legends. The first page of the article should contain: 1) title of article which should represent the subject content of the article, should be brief and specific, 2) name(s) of author(s), full address(es), 3) e-mail ID of the author to whom correspondence should be sent, 4) an abstract, not exceeding 250 words, conveying the main points of the paper and 5) a maximum of five key words.

## Abbreviations

Abbreviations of units of measurement, biological terms, chemical names and other technical terms in the body of the paper should be used after they are defined clearly in the place they first appear in the text. Abbreviations which would be readily recognized by scientists outside the author's field, may be used without definition.

## Tables, figures and legends

Tables should only include essential data needed to support important points in the text. Each table should be prepared in MS Excel or any compatible format. Tables should be serially numbered with captions and self explanatory material. All tables should be referred to in the text consecutively. All figures should be referred to in the text and numbered consecutively (Fig. 1, Fig. 2, *etc.*). Figures (histograms, pie diagrams, *etc.*) should be prepared in MS Excel or any compatible format; photographs and line drawings, scanned at 300 dpi, should be sent as attachment file (.tif, .eps, .jpg). The legends should be provided separately.

## References

References should be cited in the text at the appropriate places (*e.g.*, Sharma and Mohanan, 2000; Muralidharan *et al.*, 2005). References should include only published materials. The list of references at the end of the text should be in the following format:
